THE STARTING POINT

Why This Matters

Stewardship here means something larger than environmental protection.

It connects land, culture, knowledge, governance, employment, conservation and Nationhood as one piece of work rather than several.

WHY IT MATTERS TO INDIGENOUS NATIONS

Indigenous-led conservation can strengthen cultural connections, support healthier ecosystems, create employment, move knowledge between generations, and strengthen a Nation's authority over its territory.

The knowledge, capacity and systems to exercise decision-making authority.

KEY CONCEPT 01

Indigenous Guardians

Guardians are the eyes and ears on traditional territories. The work includes monitoring wildlife and plants, managing protected areas, collecting data and research, supporting cultural and language programs, responding to environmental pressures and strengthening community resilience.

HOW FAST IT HAS GROWN

ILI reports First Nations Guardians programs rising from roughly 30 in 2016 to more than 200 in 2024.

KEY CONCEPT 02

Knowledge & Decision-Making

Guardians do more than record environmental conditions. The information they gather strengthens a Nation's ability to determine what happens within its territory, and on what terms. ILI describes that decision-making capacity as an essential component of Nationhood.

WHY THIS REACHES CARBON

The link between land-based knowledge, credible data and Indigenous decision-making is exactly what conservation, natural climate solutions and carbon projects depend on.

KEY CONCEPT 03

Protected & Conserved Areas

ILI supports the development of Indigenous Protected and Conserved Areas, placing Nations in leadership roles in protecting lands and waters while holding together conservation, Indigenous laws, knowledge systems, culture and community priorities.

THE PRINCIPLE IT DEMONSTRATES

Conservation and economic opportunity do not have to be opposing objectives.

KEY CONCEPT 04

Conservation Creates Value

Guardians programs create employment and regional economic opportunity while supporting stewardship and stronger Indigenous decision-making.

ILI cites research on two emerging Guardians programs in the Northwest Territories, measuring social, economic, cultural and environmental value. Projections suggest more with national-network support.



Birch Carbon INSIGHTS



READ THIS CAREFULLY

A Territory Is Not a Tonnage

A carbon project should never reduce a Nation's territory to a calculation of tonnes.

Forests, wetlands, peatlands and waters sit inside a much larger relationship involving Indigenous rights, responsibilities, culture, biodiversity, knowledge, governance and future generations.

BIRCH CARBON PROGRAM PERSPECTIVE

Leadership First, Then Projects

ILI's work reinforces putting Indigenous leadership first and letting environmental and economic initiatives support a Nation's broader objectives, rather than setting them.

WHAT THAT MEANS IN PRACTICE

Guardians, monitoring capacity and governance are not preliminaries to a carbon project. They are what makes one credible and durable.

THE KEY TAKEAWAY

Stewardship capacity and decision-making authority are the foundation everything else stands on.

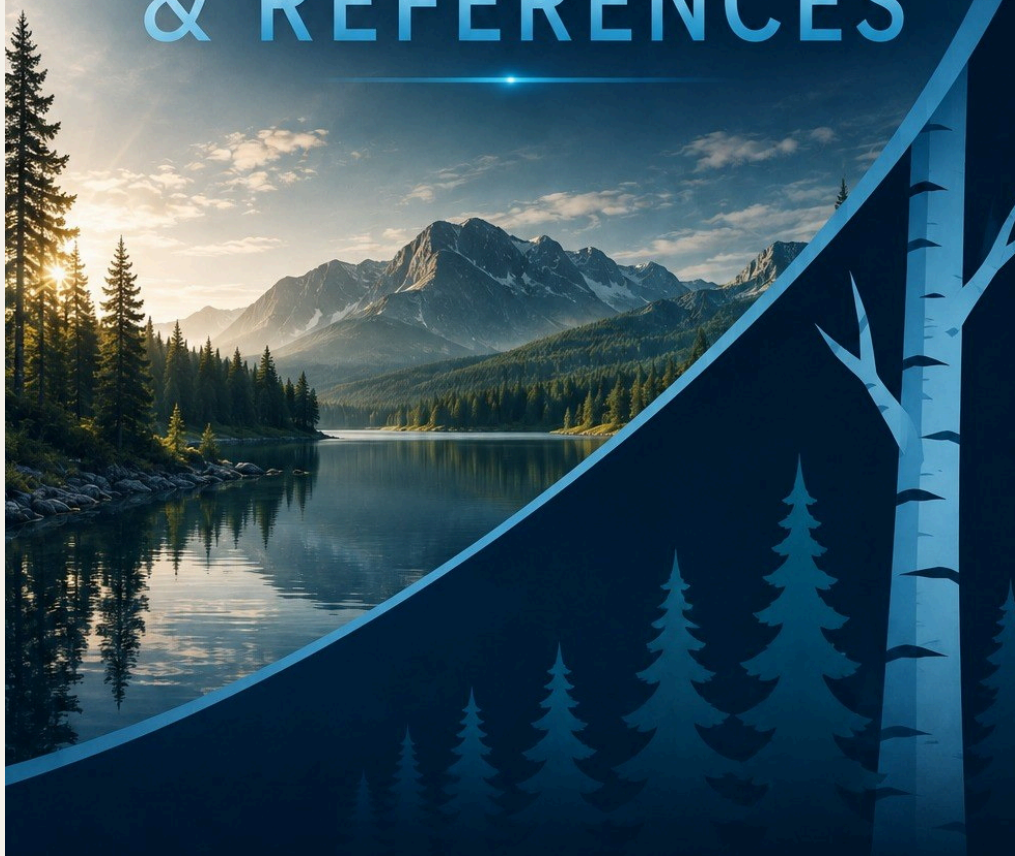
Land, culture, knowledge, governance, employment, conservation and Nationhood belong in the same conversation.
